

1. Greens Gunyah Museum / Visitor Information Outlet

There is a wealth of material in the Greens Gunyah Museum, with an extensive range of historical artefacts, photography and machinery displayed, all with their own story to tell. The Museum is also home to the well-known Doris Golder Wool Art Gallery.

2. Lockhart Sculpture and Heritage Trail

Take a stroll around the award-winning Lockhart Sculpture and Heritage Trail and discover Incredible Farm Art.

3. Lockhart Shire Walk of Fame

The Lockhart Shire Walk of Fame is established in Walter Day Park, only a short stroll from the Caravan Park, to honour Lockhart Shire residents whose skill, character and contribution to Australia has been exceptional.

4. Water Tower Murals

Lockhart Shire has three large scale water tower murals located in Lockhart Milbrulong, and Yerong Creek.

5. Pastoral Shadows of Brookong

The Pastoral Shadows of Brookong is an easy-grade, circular walk that takes you on a pictorial trail of Lockhart's history, creating a story through the use of rusted iron, scraps of metal, and other natural materials.

6. Green Street Shopping

Indulge in retail therapy or enjoy a delicious meal or drink Wander under historic Federation verandahs, read the stories of original shopfronts and discover more than 400 etched pavers, artistically displaying a visual record of the social history of the Lockhart Region.

7. The Rock Nature Reserve – Kengal Aboriginal Place

The Rock Nature Reserve – Kengal Aboriginal Place offers scenic picnic spots, walking opportunities, and birdwatching.
